An overview of yarn exported from India

Fiber-wise exports

Indian exporters shipped a total of 2357 containers of yarn in the month of December amounting to US\$140 Mn, of which 97% of the total yarn exported was from conventional fiber and of conventional blends, i.e., 100% cotton, 100% viscose, PV, 100% polyester and PC.

Realization-wise break up

Close to 70% of the total volume of yarn exported was in the price range of US\$2-3 /Kg while 22% of the total yarn export was in the price range of US\$3-6/Kg. Cheaper yarn in the range of US\$1-2 per Kg accounted for just 5% of the total volume exported in December 2007. The premium segment, that is price over US\$6/Kg accounted for 3% of total exports.

In all, 81 Countries imported yarn from India in the month but 90% of the volume was directed to 28 countries. The top 10 destination countries, imported 60% of the yarn quantity and the next 10 countries consumed another 22%. Turkey was the top importer with 273 FCL of yarn followed by Bangladesh with 249 FCL. Interestingly South American countries like Brazil (164 FCL) and Peru (148 FCL) were among the top importers and although Italy stood at 6th position in terms of volumes, is the 3rd largest importer in terms of value.

Specialty /High Value products

In the total volume of exports, around 4% was of specialty yarns. The weighted average

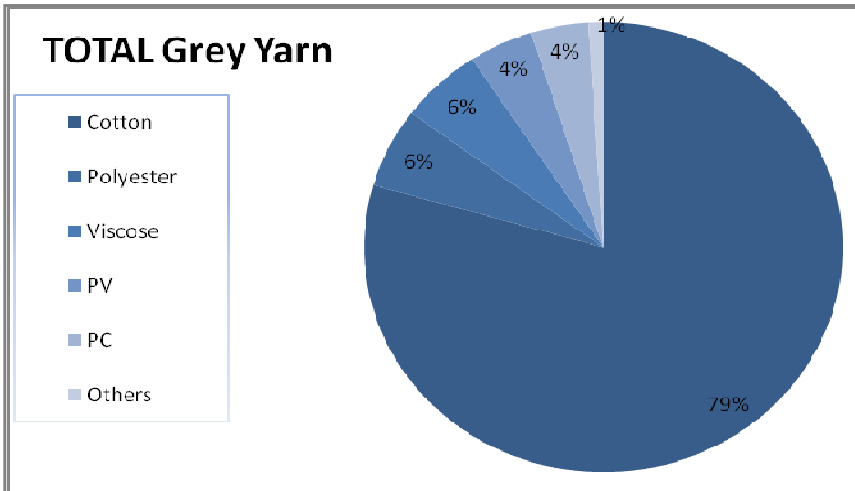

Among all the counts in respective yarn types 30s and 40s cotton yarn were the major products exported during December and In terms of volume, together accounted for 30% of total exports. The major quantities of 30/1 cotton yarn was imported by Peru, Bangladesh and Brazil, where as 40s was imported mainly by Turkey, Bangladesh and S. Korea (Details about count-wise products are covered in the detailed analysis below).

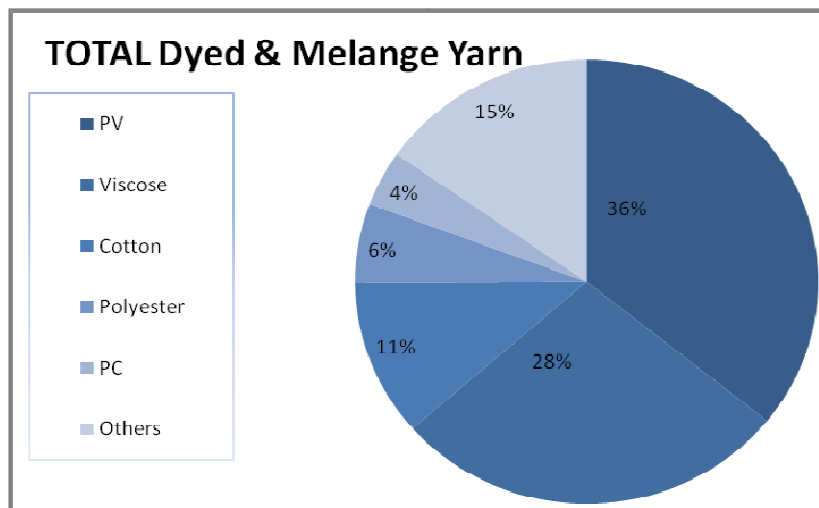

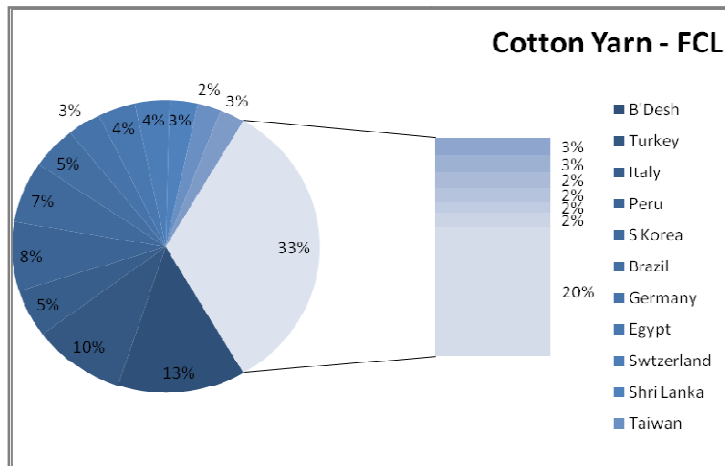

Cotton Yarn

Major countries importing cotton yarn

A total of 35,360 MT of cotton yarn was exported by Indian spinners in the month of December



of which 72% (25,644 MT) was combed, 17% (6,220 MT) was carded and 3% was open-end yarn, rest was unidentified.

Total cotton dyed yarn export volume was at 170 MT whereas mélange type was about 140 MT. Of the 7 countries who bought 50% of the volume of

exports of cotton yarn in the month, Bangladesh and Turkey were among the largest. Israel gave the lowest realization at US\$ 2.12/Kg where as the highest realization was from exports to Italy at US\$ 4.57/Kg. The biggest share of exports to Bangladesh was of 30/1 Combed; where as Turkey's activities were mainly around 40/1 combed. Italy, the fifth largest importer, imported a mix of counts of both knitting and weaving and the major ones were 24/1, 30/1, 30/2, 40/1, 50/1, 60/1, 80/2.

The major counts both in carded and combed seem to be more for knitting. The per Kg difference between carded and combed on a weighted average realization was at 14 cents for 30/1 and for 20/1 the difference was higher at 30 cents in case of 40/1 it was 23 cents and 31 cents in case of 24/1.

Italy the third largest importer, imported a mix of counts both knitting and weaving. The major were 24/1, 30/1, 30/2, 40/1, 50/1, 60/1, 80/2.

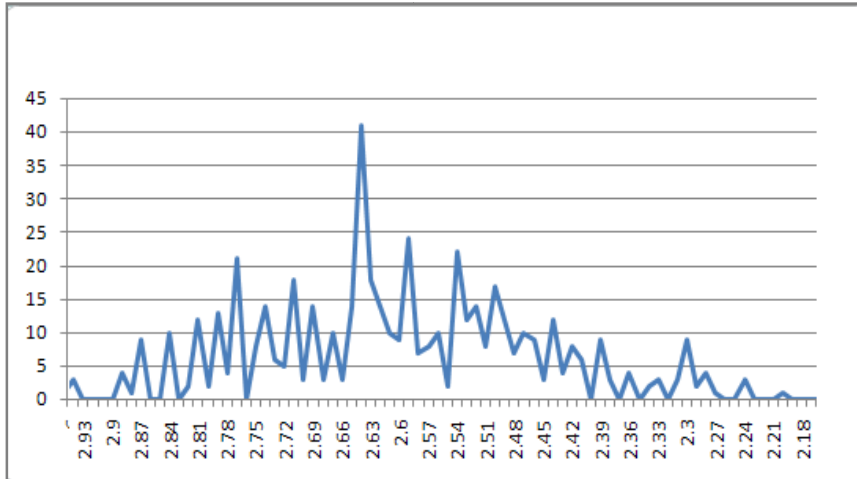

30/1 Combed Yarn

Bangladesh imported 42 FCL of this count at a weighted average price of US\$2.79 a Kg. Peru and S Korea were almost at par with 41FCL and 40 FCL respectively. Total 16 Mills exported to Bangladesh, 12 exporters exported to Peru and the S. Korean market and for Brazil, the total shippers were 13.

There were a total of 97 transactions for the product amounting to 8,225 MT. Most of the transactions were in the price range of US\$ 2.52/Kg and US\$ 2.67/Kg while US\$ 2.64/Kg was the most traded price with 41

transactions.

40/1 Combed Yarn

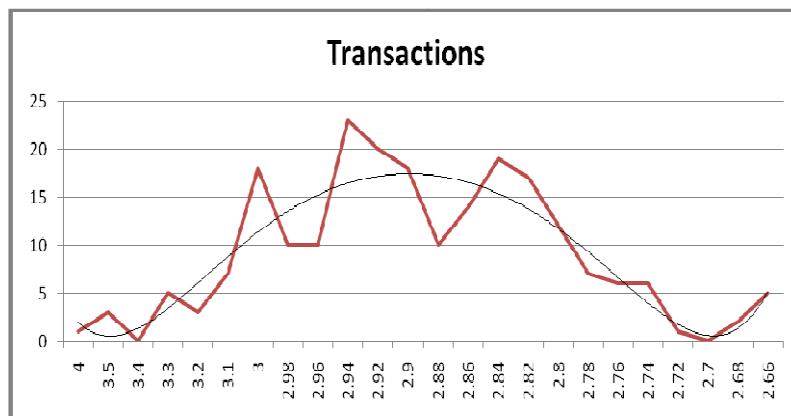
A total of 4,350 MT of 40s yarn was exported in December, 07 of which 91% was combed (4,000

MT), and the rest was carded. Total 68 companies exported 40/1 Combed yarn, out of which 26 companies exported to Turkey and 10 companies to Bangladesh. Export to Korea was taken up by 8 companies and 6 companies exported to Switzerland.

Price movement of 40/1 combed yarn



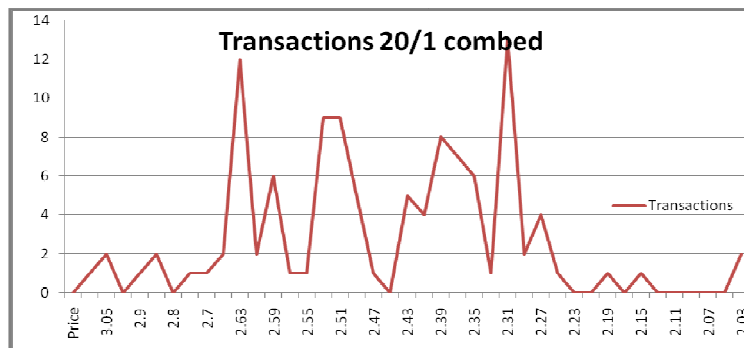

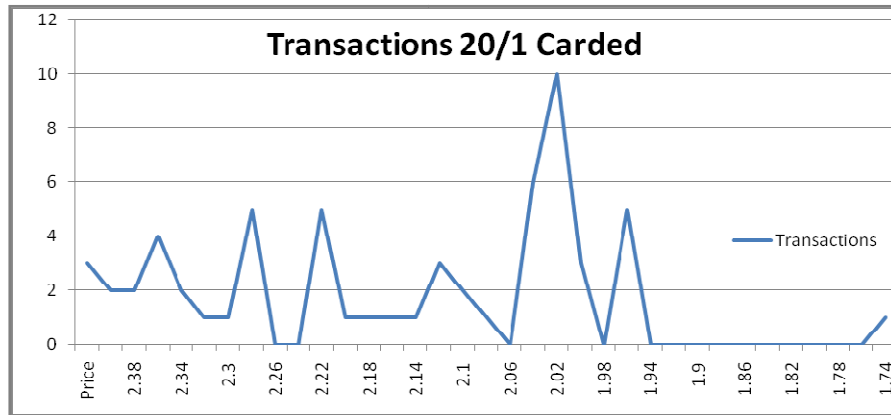
Price movement of 20/1 combed yarn



There were 30 suppliers in all for the 20s count, for both carded and combed. 12 transactions were done at US\$2.63/Kg, 9 transactions each at US\$2.53/Kg and US\$2.51/Kg, 8 transactions at US\$2.39/Kg and 12 transactions at US\$2.31/Kg. These

made up the maximum transactions in the 20/1 count. The best price was fetched from Turkey, Sri Lanka and Peru respectively.

Highest transactions took place at US\$2.02/Kg that is around 10 transactions approximately with 300 MT or 16 FCL and 5 transactions each were also concluded at US\$ 2.28, US\$2.22, US\$1.96

per Kg at FOB terms.

Grey Viscose yarn Destinations

Though the demand for viscose yarn is decreasing, viscose stood at the second position in Dec, 07. Undoubtedly the viscose yarn spinners from India are gaining the name for quality but are still finding a close competition for prices from the Indonesian market. Out of the total 3,300 MT exported 74 % was in the Grey and remaining was in Dyed and Mélange. The top 10 Countries bought 60% of the total viscose grey exports. Surprisingly Iran was at the first position with approximately 25% of the total grey yarn share amongst the top ten destination followed by Brazil. The average FOB price of all viscose yarn was US\$3.83/Kg. In dyed yarns exports to Belgium made up 68 % of the total volume followed by Egypt and Italy. The

average Indian price per Kg in dyed viscose was US\$ 4.18, FOB terms.

In the grey yarn category, 30s viscose ring spun dominated the exports making up 55% of the volumes exported to various destinations followed by 24/1 viscose grey yarn.

The quantity for the other counts categories seems to be in the same but due the unavailability of clear indication it is accounted in the others category.

16/4 was exported around 230 MT mainly to Belgium and Germany.

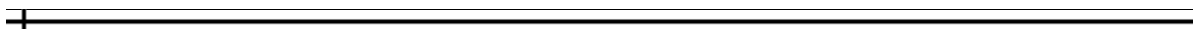

30/1 Ring Viscose was the highest exported count in the viscose category. The average FOB price gained by India in this product was US\$3.75/Kg, FOB terms. Though Iran topped the amount of buying but was lowest in the realization. The maximum realization was gained by Italy followed by Peru. The volumes in Turkey were low in the month as the country is favoring China and Indonesia for the viscose yarn.

Around 230 MT of 16/4 Viscose Dyed yarn was exported and was the second largest count exported in the viscose category. The main destination of the count was Belgium and Germany. The Average price gained by the product was US\$4.25/Kg, FOB terms.

24/1 viscose grey yarn was the third most exported yarn from India. The average rate for the product in this month was 3.60/Kg; FOB terms .The top destinations for the yarn was Egypt, Morocco and Argentina. The highest price realization came from the Great Britain market which was \$ 3.88/Kg US\$ FOB.

price of US\$ 2.01/Kg FOB. The destinations for this yarn were entirely different as was for 30/1 PSY. Egypt was the top destination with 69% of the total volumes in the category. Turkey was at second position paying US\$ 0.02

per Kg more than Peru.
